

# VET APPLIED FASHION DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY VCE UNITS 1-4

## What's it all about?

The Certificate II in Applied Fashion Design and Technology is the perfect starting point for anyone who loves fashion, or working with fabric and design, and who would like a career in the fashion industry. This course provides an introductory overview of the fashion design and production process. You will learn how to create fashion illustrations, both by hand and digitally, put together colour and fabric proposals, modify patterns and designs, and make garments.

## What type of things will I do?

The subjects will include design, pattern making, garment construction, fashion illustration and textiles. Over the two year course you will produce a design folio and several garments of your choice

## What can this lead to?

This course is a starting point if you are interested in further study and a career in the fashion design field. This could include fashion design, pattern making and drafting, production, marketing or styling. It provides an introductory overview of fashion design, which may lead to employment opportunities producing fashion products where a basic understanding of design skills is required. It is suitable for those who aspire to start their own small fashion business, or undertake repairs and alterations for themselves or others.
